4. Maintain Level and Alignment Ensure trays are level and aligned along the intended route. Subcontractor teams or installers should control lines and levels during installation to prevent sagging or misalignment .
5. Use Accessories for Safety and Organization Install covers, barrier strips, or cable protection rings to prevent cable damage and maintain organization. These accessories also enhance safety by reducing exposure to mechanical or environmental hazards .
6. Follow Manufacturer and Project Specifications Always adhere to the manufacturer's installation instructions and project-specific requirements. This ensures compliance with industrial standards and prevents structural or operational issues .
