Cabling: A fiber optic cable runs from the junction box to the ONT, often requiring a small hole drilled through the wall .

Professional Installation: Installing the junction box and connecting it to an ONT requires specialized tools and knowledge, so it is typically performed by trained technicians .

Protection: Junction boxes must be protected from moisture, dust, and physical damage to maintain signal integrity .
