

Argentine Indoor Electrical Distribution Box Standards

Indoor electrical distribution boxes in Argentina must comply with Resolution 16/2025, follow IEC/IRAM standards, and use US-compatible single-gang boxes for switches and outlets. Regulatory Framework Argentina regulates electrical equipment through Resolution No. 16/2025, which establishes essential quality and safety requirements for electrical products marketed in the country. This resolution is part of a broader conformity framework under Resolution No. 237/2024, requiring manufacturers and importers to provide a Sworn Declaration of Conformity and, in some cases, certification according to Annex III procedures. Compliance ensures that electrical distribution boxes meet safety, durability, and performance standards.

Standards and Certification Indoor electrical distribution boxes must adhere to technical standards set by recognized bodies such as IEC, IRAM, and EN. Products requiring certification follow one of the conformity assessment schemes (1b, 2, 3, 4, or 5), and certified products must carry the appropriate conformity marking. For non-regulated products, international certifications like UL, CSA, or ETL are widely accepted, provided the equipment is rated for Argentina's 220–240V system.

Box Types and Dimensions For residential and commercial indoor installations, Argentina uses US-compatible single-gang boxes for light switches and outlets, and octagonal boxes for ceiling or wall-mounted lights. The standard rectangular box size is approximately 5 cm by 10 cm, similar to the US 2x4 inch single-gang “handy box”. Square switch boxes are not used, and devices must match the gang configuration of the box. Industrial and commercial distribution panels may include breaker panels, junction boxes, and control panels with configurations ranging from 12 to 42 circuits, often equipped with bus bars for current distribution.
