Hangers should be installed using compatible components designed for the specific tray system to ensure structural integrity. Installation Procedure Mark hanger positions according to the layout plan, ensuring alignment and level installation. Install support elements such as threaded rods, struts, or brackets securely to the building structure. Attach cable trays or ladders to the hangers using approved clamps or fasteners, maintaining proper spacing and alignment. Maintain minimum bend radius for cables at tray exits to prevent damage. Check load distribution to avoid overloading any single hanger and ensure compliance with manufacturer specifications.
