Materials for Joint Plates

- Galvanized Iron (GI):** Offers good corrosion resistance and affordability; hot-dip galvanized versions provide enhanced protection for indoor and general-purpose installations.
- Stainless Steel:** Provides superior corrosion resistance, suitable for harsh environments like chemical plants or coastal areas. Though more expensive, it ensures long-term reliability.
- Mild Steel with Powder Coating:** Balances cost and protection, ideal for indoor installations where moisture is minimal.

Installation Considerations

- Ensure proper torque control on nuts and bolts to prevent loosening due to vibration.
- For tray widths of 400 mm or more, a joint plate is necessary to avoid transverse bending; for widths up to 300 mm, it may be optional.
