Yes, SD-WAN devices can be remotely configured with new network devices using automated onboarding and centralized management systems. Automated Onboarding and Zero-Touch Provisioning Modern SD-WAN solutions support remote configuration of new devices through automated processes such as Plug-and-Play (PnP) and Zero-Touch Provisioning (ZTP). These methods allow new hardware or virtual devices to be shipped to remote sites and automatically integrated into the SD-WAN network once powered on and connected to the internet or WAN transport . The devices authenticate with the SD-WAN controllers (e.g., vBond, vManage, vSmart in Cisco SD-WAN) using serial numbers and certificates, then download their configuration and join the overlay network without manual intervention . Centralized Management SD-WAN controllers, such as Cisco SD-WAN Manager or Panorama for Palo Alto Networks, provide a centralized platform to manage device configurations. Administrators can predefine templates, device groups, and policies, which are automatically pushed to new devices when they connect . This ensures consistent configuration across all sites and reduces the risk of misconfigurations. Security and Authentication Remote onboarding is secured through certificate-based authentication and device registration keys. Devices validate their identity with the SD-WAN controllers before receiving configuration data, ensuring that only authorized devices are added to the network . For enterprise networks, Root CA certificates or pre-installed certificates can be used to strengthen security during remote provisioning . Remote Access Integration Some SD-WAN solutions, like Cisco Catalyst SD-WAN Remote Access, extend the SD-WAN fabric to remote users and devices, allowing them to be treated as part of the branch LAN.
