- Mesh-Like Setup:** Two routers can share the same SSID for seamless roaming, but they must operate on different channels to avoid interference, and security settings should match.

Place the primary router centrally for optimal coverage. Position the secondary router where the primary signal is strong but coverage is weak. Use Ethernet cables (CAT5E or higher) for stable connections between routers. Avoid do...
