Load Capacity: Brackets and trays should be designed to carry a load of 100 kg/m, ensuring they can support the weight of multiple charging cables.

Alignment: Trays should be installed flat and level wherever possible. Vertical or edgewise installations are only used in special cases, with cables secured using stainless steel strips (two per meter for vertical trays).

Cable Tray Layout Review the approved shop drawings to determine tray routes, lengths, and bracket positions. Trays should run under flooring or walkways when indoors, and on the topmost level of pipe racks outdoors. Ensure adequate clearance from walls, vehicles, and other structures to allow safe cable routing and maintenance access.

Safety and Quality Assurance All operatives must attend safety induction and demonstrate competency in cable tray installation. Supervisors should monitor installation, ensuring compliance with approved proced...
