

Color Specifications for Wires in Level 3 Distribution Boxes



Overview

The mandatory colors for power wiring in the National Electrical Code (NEC) are Green, Bare, or Green/Yellow (a yellow stripe or band on green) for the protective ground (PG), and White (or alternatively Gray) for the neutral wire. This tutorial will discuss the wiring color codes for AC (single-phase and three-phase) and DC power systems based on the NEC and IEC standards. Many countries, including the UK (BS-7671), China, Russia, Hong Kong, Singapore, Ukraine, Belarus, Kazakhstan, Turkey, Israel, South Africa, Argentina. This guide covers European wire color codes for both AC (Alternating Current — mains and wall outlet power) and DC (Direct Current — batteries and electronics) supply wiring, including single-phase, three-phase, and multiple DC configurations.
