

Configuration Method for Optical Ports of Managed Switches

To configure an optical management port, assign an IP address, enable the interface, and optionally configure VLANs and monitoring features.

Step 1: Access the Switch Connect to the switch using a console cable or existing management IP. For CLI-based switches like Dell OS10 or Cisco NCS 1001, log in with administrative credentials (e.g., admin/admin for default Dell OS10) and enter privileged mode.

Step 2: Enter Configuration Mode For CLI switches: `CodeCopyconfigure` terminal This allows you to modify interface settings.

Step 3: Identify the Optical Management Port On Cisco NCS 1001, the optical SFP management port is typically `MgmtEth0/RP0/CPU0/1`. On Dell OS10, optical ports are usually labeled as `TenGigabitEthernet` or `FortyGigabitEthernet` interfaces. On Omada switches, the optical port may correspond to a specific PON or SFP port connected to the OLT.

Step 4: Assign IP Address Configure the IP address for management: `CodeCopyinterface MgmtEth0/RP0/CPU0/1 ipv4 address ipv6 address / no shutdown` For Dell OS10: `CodeCopyinterface TenGigabitEthernet 1/1/1 ip address 192.168.1.10/24 no shutdown` This enables the port and allows remote management.

Step 5: Configure VLANs (Optional) If the optical port is part of a VLAN for management or service separation: `CodeCopyswitchport mode accessswitchport access vlan` For multiple services (Internet, VOIP, IPTV), assign PVIDs or VLANs to each port as needed.

Step 6: Enable Monitoring and Features Enable LLDP to discover neighboring devices: `CodeCopylldp run` Enable port monitoring, loopback detection, or PoE keepalive if supported. For optical ports, ensure the SFP module is recognized and active.

Step 7: Verify Configuration Check interface status and routing: `CodeCopyshow running-configshow interface MgmtEth0/RP0/CPU0/1show ip route` Ensure the interf...
