

Configuration Method of Multi-Port Ring Network Switch

Multi-port ring network switches are configured using redundancy protocols like N-Ring, MRP, DLR, ERPS, or Turbo Ring, which define ring managers, member nodes, port roles, and recovery mechanisms to ensure fast fault detection and network resilience.

Key Steps for Configuring a Multi-Port Ring Network

- Select the Redundancy Protocol**
 - N-Ring (N-Tron):** Requires a Ring Manager switch and supports up to 250 managed or 50 unmanaged switches. Health check packets are sent around the ring to detect faults, with automatic rerouting in ~30 ms if a break occurs.
 - Media Redundancy Protocol (MRP, IEC 62439-2):** Uses a Media Redundancy Manager (MRM) and Media Redundancy Clients (MRCs). Recovery times range from 200-500 ms depending on the configuration. MRP operates at the MAC layer and is often used with PROFINET networks.
 - Device Level Ring (DLR, Cisco):** Requires a ring supervisor and normal ring nodes. Supports redundant gateways and fast fault detection in Ethernet/IP networks.
 - Ethernet Ring Protection Switching (ERPS, Huawei):** Supports multi-ring topologies with control VLANs, ERP instances, sub-rings, and topology change notifications. Provides fast convergence for carrier-class networks.
 - Turbo Ring / Turbo Ring V2 / Turbo Chain (Moxa):** Proprietary protocols with recovery times under 50 ms for Gigabit ports. Supports port trunking and flexible topologies.
- Assign Port Roles**
 - Ring Manager / Supervisor:** Controls the ring, monitors health, and initiates rerouting in case of faults.
 - Member Nodes / Clients:** Participate in the ring, forwarding traffic and responding to manager signals.
 - Owner Ports / RPL Ports (ERPS):** Designated ports responsible for blocking or forwarding traffic to prevent loops.
 - Trunked Ports:** Can be grouped to increase bandwidth and redundancy, often used in Turbo Ring or ERPS configurations.
