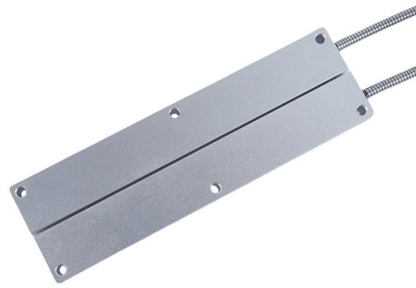


Configuration of switches in a home electrical distribution box

- Load MCBs (Single or Double Pole):** Protect individual circuits or appliances.
- Busbars and Links:** Distribute neutral and earth connections to all circuits.

Step-by-Step Configuration

Turn Off Power: Ensure the main supply is disconnected before starting any work. Use a voltage tester to confirm no live current is present.

Connect the Main Supply: Connect the phase (live) and neutral wires from the incoming supply to the input terminals of the main MCB. The main MCB acts as the isolator for the entire distribution box.

Connect the RCCB: Connect the output of the main MCB to the input of the RCCB. The RCCB will monitor leakage currents and protect against electric shocks.

Connect Load MCBs: For single-pole MCBs, connect only the phase wire from the RCCB output to the MCB input. Neutral wires from the RCCB output go to the neutral busbar. For double-pole MCBs, connect both phase and neutral wires from the RCCB output to the MCB input. The output terminals then feed the respective load.

Connect Earth Wires: All earth wires from the supply and loads should be connected to the earth busbar. This ensures proper grounding and safety.

Label Circuits: Clearly label each MCB according to the circuit it controls (e.g., kitchen, lighting, AC). This h...
