

Connect the socket ground wire to the distribution box

Ground Wire Basics

The ground wire (usually bare copper or green-insulated) is a safety conductor that does not carry current during normal operation but provides a path to earth in case of a fault, preventing electric shock. In a socket, the ground wire is typically connected to:

- The metal outlet box (if metal) using a grounding screw or clip.
- The ground terminal on the socket itself.

A continuation wire that runs back to the distribution box. Plastic boxes do not require a connection to the box itself, but the wire must still run to the panel.

Routing to the Distribution Box

From the socket, the ground wire is routed along with the hot and neutral wires to the distribution board. Inside the board:

- All ground wires from branch circuits are connected to the earth/ground bus bar (PE bar) in the panel.
- The neutral bus bar collects return conductors, but in subpanels, neutral and ground must remain separate; bonding occurs only in the main panel.

Proper connection ensures that any fault current is safely directed to earth, allowing the breaker to trip if necessary.

Practical Connection Steps

At the socket: Connect the ground wire to the socket's ground terminal and, if metal, to the box.

Inside junction boxes: Use a twist-on or crimp connector to join all ground wires together, including the continuation wire to the panel.

At the distribution box: Attach the branch circuit ground wire to the ground bus bar. Ensure the bus bar is properly bonded to the panel enclosure and earth electrode system.

Check continuity: Use a tester to confirm that the socket ground is continuous back to the panel.

Safety Considerations

Never carry current on the ground wire under normal operation. Ensure subpanels do not bond neutral and ground, which could create parallel return paths and safety hazards. Follow local el...

Distribution Box Wiring Steps

The lighting and socket circuits generally use 2.5mm² wires, and the air conditioning circuit can use 2.5mm² or 4.0mm² wires. Connection method:

DISTRIBUTION BOX

Attach a ground wire from one of the threaded studs (A) at the bottom of the housing, to the mounting plate (B). Attach a second grounding wire from the mounting plate (B), to the factory

Electrical Outlet Ground Wire Connections
