

Connection method of 6 circuits in the distribution box

To connect six circuits in a distribution box, each circuit should be wired from the main breaker to individual MCBs, with proper neutral and earth connections, following safety standards and organized layout.

Step 4: Connect Incoming Power Connect the incoming phase wire to the main MCB. Connect the neutral wire to the neutral bus bar. Connect the earth wire to the earth bus bar.

Step 5: Connect Each Circuit Run the phase wire from the main MCB or RCD to the incoming terminal of each MCB. Connect the neutral wire of each circuit to the neutral bus bar. Connect the earth wire of each circuit to the earth bus bar. Ensure wires are neatly routed, bound with cable ties, and follow the left-to-right wiring direction for clarity.

Step 6: Wire Sizing Lighting and socket circuits: 2.5 mm² wires Air conditioning or heavy appliances: 2.5–4 mm² wires depending on load

Step 7: Labeling and Testing Label each MCB according to the circuit it controls (e.g., Living Room Lights, Kitchen Sockets). After wiring, perform a safety inspection to check for short circuits, loose connections, or overloads. Turn on the main power and test each circuit individually to ensure proper operation.
