

# Core Monitoring Switch Selection and Configuration

**Switch Selection Criteria**

**Managed vs Unmanaged:** Core switches should be managed, as unmanaged switches lack IP addresses and cannot be monitored effectively. Managed switches allow SNMP queries, port monitoring, and traffic analysis.

**Layer Type:** Choose multilayer switches if routing between VLANs or networks is required; otherwise, data link layer switches suffice for simple LAN connectivity.

**Port Types and Capacity:** Consider the number and type of ports (Ethernet RJ45, SFP for fiber, PoE if powering devices). Core switches often require high port density and support for stacking to expand capacity.

**Performance and Redundancy:** Look for switches with high throughput, low latency, and redundancy features (dual power supplies, link aggregation) to ensure network reliability.

**Configuration for Monitoring**

**SNMP Setup:** Enable SNMP on the switch to allow monitoring tools to query device status, port utilization, and errors. Configure community strings or SNMPv3 credentials for secure access.

**Port Monitoring:** Identify critical ports (access, trunk, hybrid, stack, PoE) and configure monitoring for status, bandwidth usage, and error rates. This helps detect misconfigurations, unauthorized devices, or unusual traffic patterns.

**Integration with Monitoring Tools:** Use tools like Nagios Core/XI or Checkmk to monitor switches. For Nagios, define hosts and services in `switch.cfg`, using plugins like `check_snmp` for port and device status, and `check_mrtgtraf` for bandwidth monitoring. Checkmk provides a holistic view of both device health and traffic flow.

**Alerts and Thresholds:** Configure alerts for port down, high utilization, or errors. Automated notifications allow proactive troubleshooting a...
