For larger conductors, the minimum internal spacing inside the box must comply with NEC 314.28, ensuring that the distance between raceway entries and opposite walls is sufficient to prevent insulation damage during wire pulls . This indirectly affects how far the box should be mounted from the pole to allow safe cable entry and bending. Height and Accessibility For outdoor pole-mounted installations, junction boxes are typically installed 20–30 cm above ground level for ease of access and maintenance . The box should also be weatherproof (IP65 or higher) if exposed to the elements, and the mounting should allow for future servicing without obstruction .
