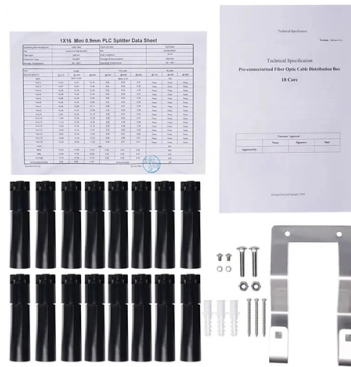


Do fiber optic patch cords require link testing
