- Interface Split (Optional):** On some high-bandwidth optical interfaces (e.g., 40GE), you may need to configure interface splitting to create multiple lower-speed logical interfaces. After splitting, the configuration must be saved and the switch restarted for changes to take effect.
- Peer Device Compatibility** Ensure that the optical modules on both switches are compatible in terms of:
 - Single-mode vs. multi-mode fiber
 - Wavelength matching for dual-fiber or single-fiber transceivers
 - Transmit power and receiver sensitivity within the supported range
 - Transmission distance supported by the modules

Summary Switching to an optical port is not purely plug-and-play. While some modern switches may auto-detect compatible transceivers, proper configuration of speed, duplex, VLAN, and interface type is often required to ensure the link functions correctly. Additionally, f...
