

Drilling holes for the back panel of the distribution box



Overview

Drill a small pilot hole through the box wall, typically using a 1/4-inch bit, to guide the subsequent cutting tool. When using a hole saw, the pilot bit guides the saw into the material before the main cutter engages the box surface. This is an outdoor main breaker panel. I can't include the photo, but they drilled 10 holes 1/2" in the back of the panel, next to the breakers.
