Overview

The Government plans to install a high-capacity fiber optic cable along the Isiolo-Mandera corridor to enhance digital connectivity and interconnect to Ethiopia and Somalia. Ethio Telecom owned about 23,000 km of fiber-optic cable across Ethiopia as of 2023, forming the national backbone and linking to neighboring undersea cables via Djibouti. Over the course of few decades, EEP has built a network of Optical Ground Wire (“OPGW”) cables along high voltage transmission lines. Optical Ground Wire is one of. While submarine communications cables are used to connect countries and continents to the Internet, terrestrial fibre optic cables are used to extend this connectivity to landlocked countries or to urban centers within a country.
