

Excess length of fiber optic cable reel



Overview

In most outside plant cables (and some indoor cables), fiber length exceeds cable length. In central tube cables, the EFL is typically zero to a fraction of 1%. Manufacturers don't publish a single universal reel length. Here's how it generally breaks down in practice: 12-fiber through 48-fiber cable — These are your feeder drops and shorter distribution runs. The formula is nothing but our old Pythagoras formula.
