- 4. Mounting and Support** Mark support locations along the wall according to the approved layout. Install threaded rod supports with metal plugs, then attach 'L' angles or slotted 'C' channels. Maintain a maximum support spacing of 1.2–3 meters, depending on tray type and load, to prevent sagging. Provide additional support at bends, branches, and offsets to maintain structural integrity.
