They consist of an optical fluid and a thickener, providing high optical clarity with absorption loss less than 0.0005% per micron of path length. Non-curing gels are shear-thinning, meaning they flow easily when applied but remain in place once the shear force is removed. Curing gels: These gels harden after application, forming a permanent optical interface. They are less common in temporary splices but are used in some long-term installations. Key Properties Refractive index: Typically around 1.457, matching silica glass used in fiber optics. Optical clarity: Transparent across near UV, visible, and near-infrared wavelengths. Particle-free: Ultra-filtered to remove particles larger than 34  $\mu\text{m}$ , ensuring minimal scattering. Temperature stability: Designed to operate over a wide temperature range without degradation. Longevity: Chemically stable with no shelf life limitations; proven to perform reliably in outdoor and long-term installations.
