4. **Preterminated and Expandable Systems:** Some panels come preterminated with intrafacility or outside plant cables, and additional preterminated pigtails or cassettes can be added to extend the panel's capacity. This reduces installation time and allows for scalable network growth.

- Connector Types:** Ensure compatibility with LC, SC, MTP/MPO, or other connectors when adding modules or cassettes.
- Fiber Management:** Raised slots, trays, or sliding shelves help maintain bend radius and prevent fiber damage when extending panels.
- Rack or Wall Space:** Verify available rack units or wall-mount space to accommodate longer or additional panels.
- Density Requirements:** High-density panels are ideal for data centers or environments with large fiber counts, allowing more fibers per RU.
