- 3. Fire-Fighting Provisions** Distribution rooms should be equipped with adequate fire-fighting equipment, such as extinguishers or automatic suppression systems, to respond quickly in case of fire ().
- 4. Intelligent Fire Monitoring Systems** Modern distribution boxes can incorporate intelligent fire protection systems that detect smoke, trigger alarms, and perform rapid power-off in emergencies (). Special-shaped inner cavity designs improve smoke detection accuracy, while double-insurance fire protection measures enhance safety.
