OSFP is defined by the OSFP Multi-Source Agreement (MSA), ensuring interoperability across vendors and compliance with IEEE standards. Scalability: OSFP supports single- or dual-port configurations with 8- or 16-lane connectivity, making it suitable for high-density OLT deployments. Compatibility: OSFP modules can work with direct-attach cables (DACs), active optical cables (AOCs), and pluggable transceivers, providing flexibility in network design.
