AI Overview

Gabon is actively expanding its fiber optic network, with ongoing projects and imports driving both domestic connectivity and regional integration. Trade and Market Data In 2024, Gabon exported \$326 worth of optical fibers and cables, primarily to Switzerland (\$319) and Canada (\$7), ranking it 154th globally in exports for this product. Imports were significantly higher at \$2.46 million, mainly from China (\$1.8M), France (\$610k), Morocco, Sweden, and Turkey, reflecting Gabon's reliance on foreign suppliers for optical cable infrastructure. The fastest-growing import origins were Sweden and Turkey, indicating emerging supplier diversification.

National Fiber Optic Projects Gabon has deployed approximately 1,628 kilometers of fiber optic cable through the Central African Backbone 4 (CAB4) project, a World Bank partnership connecting multiple regions and linking to neighboring countries such as Cameroon, Equatorial Guinea, and the Republic of Congo. The government is planning a joint venture with Moov Africa Gabon, Airtel Gabon, and SPIN to extend the national backbone by 1,800 kilometers, pool infrastructure, reduce costs, and improve service quality.

Submarine and Regional Connectivity Gabon has invested in submarine cables, including the ACE cable and SAT 3, enhancing international capacity and ensuring redundancy in case of cable damage. A 200 km submarine link between Libreville and Port-Gentil has been constructed, further strengthening national connectivity. These initiatives also support interconnection with Congo, Equatorial Guinea, and Cameroon, promoting regional integration.

Market Outlook The active optical cable market in Gabon is monitored for growth opportunities, with analysts projecting increasing demand driven by households, businesses, and public administrations seeking high-speed internet. Innovative financing models and private sector participation are being explored to accelerate deployment and reduce state expenditure.
