Bonding may only be needed if the tray introduces an external Earth potential, making it an extraneous-conductive-part. Practical Implications Galvanized trays remain conductive despite the zinc coating. The decision to earth or bond them should be based on: The type of cables they carry Whether they serve as a protective conductor Whether they could introduce external Earth potential In most standard installations with insulated or metallic-sheathed cables, galvanized trays do not need to be earthed, but they remain electrically conductive and capable of carrying current if connected in a fault path.
