

Grounding wiring of distribution box

3. **Ground the Metal Enclosure:** The metal casing of the distribution box must be electrically connected to the PE bus. This can be done using a copper wire or braided copper tape connected to a dedicated grounding bolt on the box. For stainless steel enclosures, apply conductive grease to prevent corrosion and maintain low contact resistance.
4. **Ground Internal Components:** Any electrical components inside the box that require grounding should be connected to the PE bus using copper wires. This ensures that all exposed conductive parts are safely grounded.
5. **Connect Conduit and External Metal Parts:** Metal conduits or threaded pipes entering the box should also be bonded to the box's grounding system, either by welding or using conductive connectors, to maintain a continuous grounding path.
6. **Verify Grounding Effectiveness:** After wiring, measure the resistance between the enclosure and the main grounding electrode. The resistance should be very low (typically
