

Household power distribution box and wiring

Main MCB Connection: Connect the incoming phase (live) and neutral wires from the utility supply to the input terminals of the main MCB. Tighten connections to the manufacturer's torque specifications to prevent arcing.

RCCB Connection: Connect the output of the main MCB to the input of the RCCB. The RCCB monitors leakage currents and protects against electric shock.

Branch Circuit MCBs: Connect the output of the RCCB to the input of individual MCBs. For single-pole MCBs, connect only the phase wire; for double-pole MCBs, connect both phase and neutral if required for special loads.

Neutral and Earth Connections: Connect the neutral wire from the RCCB output to the neutral bar, distributing it to all branch circuits. Connect all earth wires from the supply and branch circuits to the earth bar, which is linked to a grounding electrode like a ground rod or metal water pipe.

Load Connections: Connect the phase, neutral, and earth wires from each load (appliances, lights, outlets) to the corresponding MCB output, neutral bar, and earth bar. Additio...
