- 2. Amperage Rating** Standard modern homes usually require 200-amp service. Smaller homes may use 100-amp or 60-amp panels, but these may not support modern appliances. Large homes or homes with high-demand devices may need 400-amp service, sometimes requiring multiple panels.
- 3. Circuit Breaker Types**
  - 1P (Single Pole):** Controls only the live wire, suitable for simple circuits.
  - 1P+N (Single Pole + Neutral):** Protects both live and neutral wires.
  - 2P (Double Pole):** Provides full isolation for both live and neutral, ideal for high-power appliances.Consider RCBOs for combined overload and residual current protection, and Surge Protection Devices (SPD) for lightning or voltage spikes.
