Separate fiber and power cables: This reduces electromagnetic interference and ensures signal integrity. Label all cables and ports: Use unique IDs for each connection to simplify troubleshooting and future moves, adds, or changes. Use Velcro straps: Secure cables at regular intervals without over-tightening to prevent stress on the fibers.
