

How to connect a router with a fiber optic interface

To connect a fiber optic interface to your router, you typically use an Optical Network Terminal (ONT) to convert the fiber signal to Ethernet, then link it to your router's WAN port.

Step 1: Check Compatibility and Gather Equipment

Use an Ethernet cable to connect the ONT's LAN/Ethernet port to your router's WAN port. Power on the router and wait for the indicator lights to confirm a successful connection.

Step 4: Configure Your Router

Access the router's configuration interface via a web browser (commonly 192.168.0.1 or 192.168.1.1). Configure settings such as Quality of Service (QoS) if needed for VoIP or video calls. Most routers automatically detect the fiber connection, but manual setup may be required depending on your ISP.

Step 5: Verify the Connection

Check that your devices can access the internet. Ensure the fiber cable is securely connected and not bent sharply, as excessive bending can degrade signal quality.

Precautions

Always turn off the router before connecting the fiber cable. Avoid touching the fiber tip and use protective caps when not connected. Place ONT and router in a dry, ventilated area near power outlets, ideally with surge protection. B...
