

How to connect an indoor fiber optic network router

Step 4: Configure and Test

- Access your router's configuration interface via a web browser (commonly 192.168.0.1 or 192.168.1.1) if manual setup is required.
- Verify that the router receives an internet signal and that Wi-Fi or wired connections are functioning.

Tips and Precautions

- Handle fiber cables carefully:** Avoid touching the glass tip to prevent damage or signal loss.
- Placement:** Keep the ONT and router in a dry, ventilated area near power outlets.
- Surge protection:** Use a surge suppressor to protect your devices.
- Check compatibility:** Some routers require SFP modules or media converters for direct fiber input.
