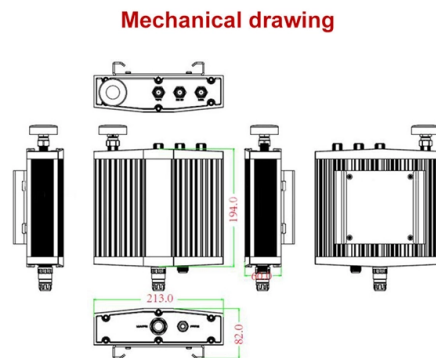

Install horizontal trays between rooftops, leaving clearance from edges and junction boxes, and connect them to vertical trays for grounding continuity. Use splice plates or couplers to join tray sections securely. Ensure all trays are level and aligned, using a level during installation.
