

How to install cables and distribution boxes

Install circuit breakers or fuses for each branch circuit to provide overload and short-circuit protection.
- Wiring Arrangement** Organize cables neatly inside the box using zip ties or cable clamps to prevent tangling and contact with sharp edges. Maintain spacing between cables according to standards: single-core cables should be separated by at least one cable diameter, and multicore cables by 50–75mm depending on configuration. Reserve space for heat dissipation and future modifications.
- Testing and Verification** Insulation resistance test: Use an insulation tester to ensure no short circuits exist between wires or between wires and the box. Circuit on/off test: Verify...
