Close the terminal chamber cover and secure it with fasteners, ensuring the explosion-proof joint surfaces are not scratched. Apply anti-rust oil on joint surfaces after maintenance and only operate the box after securing screws and washers.

Component Standards and Materials

Use stainless steel boxes (Baosteel 304 or higher) with a minimum thickness of 4 mm for durability and corrosion resistance. Ensure all electrical components comply with relevant standards, maintaining proper electrical clearance, creepage distance, and impact withstand voltage.

Maintenance and Inspection

Regularly inspect the box for damage, corrosion, or loose connections. Avoid opening the box while power is on,...
