- Termination and Splicing:** Use fusion splicers and connectors to join fibers with minimal loss. Precision is critical, as even small errors can degrade performance .
- Testing and Documentation:** Employ optical testers and OTDR machines to verify signal integrity. Document all installations for maintenance, regulatory compliance, and future upgrades .
