 - End closures: Protect cable ends and prevent accidental contact.

 - Maintain minimum bend radius for cables exiting trays to prevent damage.
 - Ensure rung spacing of 150–230 mm (6–9 inches) for ladder trays to support cables evenly.
 - Use modular systems for flexibility in routing and future expansion.
 - Verify compliance with standards such as BS EN 61537 for cable trays and BS 6946 for support systems.
5. Safety and Maintenance
 - Cable trays are not walkways; avoid placing loads beyond cable weight.
 - Inspect supports and fittings periodically to ensure structural integrity and prevent sagging or misalignment.
