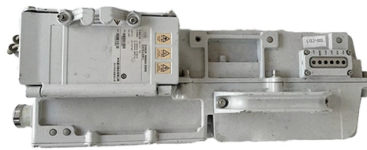


How to route a single wire in a distribution box

Earth Wire: Connect to the earth busbar or terminal, ensuring proper grounding ().

Dress the wire along the enclosure edges, avoiding sharp corners or contact with other wires. Use cable ties or clips to secure the wire and maintain separation from other conductors to prevent short circuits ().
- 5. Verify Connections**
Ensure all screws are tightened, the wire is fully inserted into terminals, and there is no exposed conductor outside the terminal. Label the wire if necessary for future maintenance ().
- 6. Test the Circuit**
After routing and connecting the wire, perform an insulation resistance test and check the circuit with the breaker in the on/off position to confirm proper operation and safety ().

By following these steps, a single wire can be safely and effectively routed in a distribution box.
