

How to shut off and restore power to a high-voltage distribution box

This ensures there is no residual voltage that could cause electric shock. For maximum safety, temporary grounding wires can be applied across the load to prevent accidental energization.
4. Lockout/Tagout (LOTO) Implement a lockout/tagout system to secure the disconnect switch in the off position. This prevents accidental re-energization while work is being performed. Only authorized personnel should remove locks or tags.
5. Emergency Shutdown Options In some facilities, remote emergency shutdown systems like the Knox Remote Power Box can be used to safely trip high-voltage circuits from a distance. These systems are typically controlled by emergency responders or authorized personnel and should be installed by licensed electricians.
