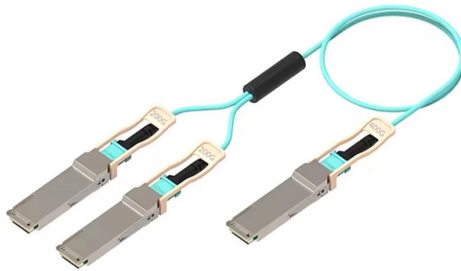


Inspection of fiber optic cold connectors

Inspection Procedure Remove protective caps only immediately before inspection or connection. Visual inspection: Examine the ferrule end face for dirt, scratches, pits, or cracks using the microscope. Check adapters and receptacles: Inspect and clean mating adapters to prevent contamination transfer. Pass/Fail evaluation: Some video microscopes provide automated results indicating whether the connector is acceptable. Cleaning Techniques Dry cleaning: Use lint-free wipes or click cleaners to remove dust and particles. Wet cleaning: Apply isopropyl alcohol sparingly, followed immediately by dry cleaning to avoid residue. Re-inspection: After cleaning, inspect again to ensure the end face is free of contaminants. Repeat as necessary: Continue cleaning and inspection until the connector passes the quality check. Best Practices Always clean both connectors before mating to prevent contamination transfer. Avoid using unfiltered magnifiers or inspecting while the system laser is on...
