- Compliance with Standards** BS 7671 and IEC 60364-5-52: Recommend wall-mounted boxes at 1.4–1.7 meters and ground-mounted boxes raised 2–4 inches to avoid moisture damage.
- Industrial vs. residential:** Industrial installations may require different heights depending on equipment layout, but residential setups generally follow the 1.4–1.8 meter range.
- Consistency:** In large projects with multiple boxes, maintain a consistent height for operational convenience and safety.
