- Total Quantity and Weight:** Calculate the total weight per meter/foot of the cable bundle, including a 20–30% margin for future expansion.
- Bend Radius:** Ensure the tray accommodates the minimum bend radius of fiber optics and high-grade copper cables to prevent damage.
- Material and Finish:** Choose materials based on environmental conditions—steel, aluminum, stainless steel, PVC-coated, or FRP for corrosive areas.
- Support and Installation:** Follow NEC Article 392 for proper support spacing, bonding, and grounding. Ladder trays typically require longer support spans (12–30 feet), while channel or single rail trays are suitable for shorter spans (5–10 f...
