- Connect to Appropriate Boards:** For 1+1 OTS protection, interconnect the OLP board with the FIU or OA board. For 1+1 OMS protection, connect it with the MUX/DMUX or ROADM board.
- Enable Protection Switching:** Configure the module to monitor optical power and automatically switch to the protection fiber if the working fiber fails, ensuring continuous service.
