For duplex fiber, one strand is Tx and the other is Rx. For single-fiber transceivers, ensure the wavelengths match. Verify the link: Check the port LEDs or use commands like `show interface status` to confirm the optical link is active. Enable VLANs or interfaces if necessary. On Cisco switches, you may need to issue `no shutdown` on the VLAN interface to bring it up. Compatibility Considerations Fiber type: Single-mode (SMF) for long distances, multi-mode (MMF) for short distances. Both switches must use the same type. Wavelength: Ensure SFPs have matching transmit and receive wavelengths. Mismatched wavelengths prevent link establishment. Port speed and duplex: Both optical ports should support the same speed (1G, 10G, etc.) and duplex mode. Distance: Verify the fiber length does not exceed the maximum supported by the SFP modules.
