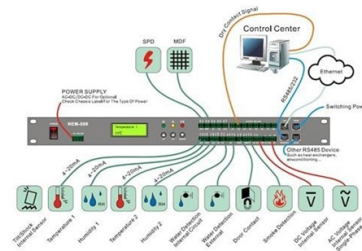

These speeds are made possible because fiber transmits data as pulses of light, which travel at approximately 67% of light's speed in a vacuum through glass, far surpassing the electron-based transmission in copper cables.

Factors Affecting Fiber Speed Several factors influence fiber optic internet speed:

- Fiber type:** Single-mode fibers (SMF) support higher speeds over long distances (e.g., 100 Gbps over 40-100 km), while multimode fibers (MMF) are suited for shorter distances (e.g., 10 Gbps over 300 meters) due to modal dispersion.
- Wavelength and modulation:** Using wavelengths like 1310 nm or 1550 nm and advanced modulation techniques (e.g., PAM4) can maximize data throughput.
- Network equipment:** Transceivers, switches, and repeaters can affect signal integrity and overall speed.
- Distance:** Signal loss increases over long distances, but boosters or repeaters can extend coverage without significant speed reduction.
