Overview

The fiber optic cable between the two is a crossover cable - this connects the light from the TX of one device to the RX of the other. From what I recall the various standards bodies (ANSI/TIA/EIA) call for crosses at every point (patch cables on both ends and infrastructure cabling) so that you always have 1 cross in the end.
