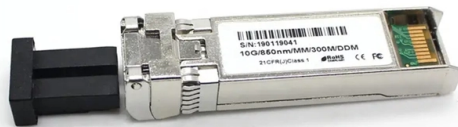


Loose household electrical distribution box

- Device vs. box:** If only the device (switch or outlet) moves but the box is stable, the issue is with the device-to-box connection.

Safety Precautions Before Repair Turn off power at the main circuit breaker controlling the affected circuit. Verify power is off using a non-contact voltage tester or multimeter before touching any wires. Use proper protective equipment, such as gloves and safety glasses, especially when working in ceilings or tight spaces.

Repair Methods

- Recessed box:** If the box is too deep, use a box extender or extension ring to bring it flush with the wall surface. Electrical shims or spacers can also help align the device yoke with the wall.
- Loose mounting:** For boxes moving freely in the wall cavity, check for damaged drywall, stripped screw holes, or broken internal tabs. Tighten screws or use retrofit hardware to secure the box to a stud or wall structure.
- Ceiling fan boxes:** Ensure the box is rated for fan support and securely fastened to a joist or brace to prevent wobbling.
