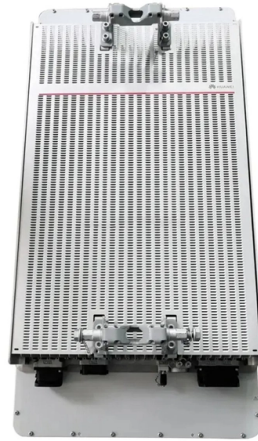


Lower Vertical Cable Tray Connection

The Trapeze or swing support is the most common type. Thread hex nut 25 mm (1") to 50 mm (2") above location of the tray bottom.
